

The Jewish Day of Atonement is September 27, this year. The day of Atonement is a time of fasting and prayer for Jewish people as they ask God to forgive their sins.

### Message: "The Atonement In Us" 1 John 1:5-7

Light is arguably the most powerful force in the universe. The spectrum of light we see is minuscule. For scientist, what ancient people referred to light is called the "electro-magnetic spectrum". Light moves in waves. What we see as light is really the "reflection" of these waves off objects. If all the wave energy is reflected the object appears "white" if it is fully absorbed it appears "black". Colors are formed when all the visible wavelengths, but that color's wavelength are absorbed.

Scientists discovered that the wavelengths travel at different frequencies and thus are called "long" or "short". On the upper end of the "short waves" are various types of radiation. On the "long wave" side are radio waves. Red is a long wave and violet [blue] is a short wave.

"White light" is the term that is used to describe the visible light spectrum. Refraction through a clear substance can separate the wavelengths causing a "rainbow effect".



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While I am sure John, when he used "light" as a metaphor for God's nature, did not understand the full ramifications of this, the Holy Spirit who inspired him did.

Ultraviolet light which is a shortwave light on the edge of our visible spectrum is now being used to "purify" water and air. Scientists since the late 1800s have known about the ability of ultraviolet light to disrupt the lifecycle of microscopic organisms. The problem is the expense in producing artificial ultraviolet light. Until the advent of LED technology the cost of using UV [ultraviolet] was prohibitively expensive for purifying water, air or surfaces.

The Day of ATONEMENT

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5 This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.

7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

#### Message: "The Atonement In Us" 1 John 1:5-7

Light defines things and makes life possible. Light may be reflected or refracted. When it is refracted by a clear substance light is slowed down in the substance when it exits it returns to its normal speed causing the refraction. Light moves at ¾ speed through water as opposed to our atmosphere. If the path of the light is refracted at an angle the different frequencies of light separate. This is the rainbow effect.






"Sad Inheritance, 1899

#### Message: "The Atonement In Us" 1 John 1:5-7

One of the Greek words used to translate Kiphur or Kippur was the word Katharizo which means "to make pure" or "to wash out". We get our English psychology term from this word: "catharsis" or "cathartic". It means to freely express emotion, but the idea is to "cleanse" the emotions by letting them out. Often after such an experience a person feels a sense of release.

Unfortunately, often the opposite happens, especially with anger. While the person may feel a momentary sense of release this "cleansing" is replaced by guilt and resentment that festers. Often freely expressing our anger often leads to deeper anger and progressively physical and uncontrolled expressions of that anger. If this "catharsis" experience does not help, what does?

What really helps is shining light on our anger and the reasons for it. That means allowing someone to ask us the hard question: "why are you angry?"

This in not only true of anger but of other emotions. For real cleansing to take place we must allow someone to ask that important "why" question. For Christians we<sup>20, 2020</sup> believe that in Christ's atonement he asks us that "why"




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
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Caravaggio is by many considered the 1st Master of Light. He used light and shadows to tell a story. Considered in the late 1500 and early 1600s the best painter in Italy if not Europe. He was often involved in drunken brawls and killed a man and seriously injured several others. He died unexpectedly in 1610. Revenge was suspected. His body was exhumed and his bones were found to contain high levels of lead oxide which was used in paints to give a bright white. It is now believed he died of lead poisoning. Due to his paints.

Some of us are so afraid of our emotions that we bottle them up like a shaken bottle of pop. We are just one bottle opening event from exploding all over others and ourselves. Others of us are so free with our emotions that we mindlessly charge through relationships like the proverbial bull in a china shop.

What causes these emotional crises within each of us? In Genesis 3 we are told that humanity fell and as Paul indicates in Romans that fall brought not only physical death but spiritual death as well. We call what Adam and Eve did "original sin". Strangely it taints every aspect of our humanity. But most of all it taints our emotions...we move from anger...to jealousy...to ridicule...to contempt...to lust...to guilt...to greed...to self-loathing - all in the space of a few moments. Genesis 3 tells us that this all began with shame in the fall. Adam and Eve try to cover their shame by constructing fig leaf aprons to cover their bodies, a solution that would not even last the day.

The attempt to hide themselves from the ridicule and anger of the other and more importantly to hide themselves from the gaze of God. Adam has a cathartic moment when he blames Eve. Eve has her cathartic moment when she blames the serpent...well, the serpent didn't have anyone to blame he remained angry. Adam and Eve unclothed in God's presence remained under His wrath.

Rembrandt is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Master of Light. He moved through life scheming and wasting his wealth and his son's wealth. He was unfaithful to his wife and because he wished to maintain control of his son's inheritance from his mother. Rembrandt lived in a common law relationship with one of his maids following after death of his wife. As a result this woman was shunned in the community.

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God does something unusual for Adam and Eve. First, He kills two animals and prepares the hides to cover the nakedness of His human creations. It was the first symbolic act of atonement by blood sacrifice. Next he drives them away from the garden and specifically the Tree of Life, before they could eat of it and have no hope of cleansing from sin within and without. Paul in Romans 8:20 tells us that God in this act, sacrificed His entire creation in order to salvage humanity. Death entered all of creation so that when God purified humanity through Jesus Christ's atonement and resurrection All creation would be rescued by as Paul says the revelation of the children of God.





Jesus tells us this can only be accomplished in our hearts by allowing his light to enter us. Like Adam and Eve we are shielded by the atonement sacrifice from the withering gaze of God's holiness. We become wanders in this world but we are not alone Christ has sent his Spirit into our heart allowing us to Call God "Father".

Vermeer the 3<sup>rd</sup> Master of Light, was a hardworking artist devoted to his family like Sorolla. He was not flashy like Rembrandt. He was almost forgotten as an artist, and his paintings attributed to Rembrandt or his workshop. His best known painting "Girl with a Pearl Earring" [considered by many to be the best European painting] was purchased in the mid 1800s by a collector who thought it was a Rembrandt. He stored it poorly when it was discovered not be a Rembrandt. It was severely damaged. The painting was repaired and restored in the early 1900s. Vermeer was rediscovered in the late 1800s and is now considered one of the best European painters. Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the **pure** in heart, For they shall see God.

Many municipalities around the world have switched from treating water with chemicals to UV purification. Many public buildings now purify their air by use of UV boxes that draw the air through them. And hospitals are sterilizing instruments and even operating rooms using UV.


